## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q. Are ticket request forms accepted after 10 December?**

A: Yes. But priority is given to schools that submitted their forms by that date. Since strong demand for these sessions is expected, schools are encouraged to send the requests as early as possible.

**Q. Our students are in different years than those recommended as most suitable. Can we still apply?**

A. Of course. We understand that the English reading levels in Hong Kong varies from school to school. Please indicate the year/form clearly on the form. If you have an questions, please e-mail [schools@festival.org.hk](mailto:schools@festival.org.hk) with details.

**Q. May I book by phone?**

A. No. The Festival requires ticket requests to be submitted with a signature and school chop.

**Q. How many supervisors are required?**

A. The Festival requires that there be at least one supervisor for every 20 students.

**Q. It is required to buy tickets for supervisors?**

A. Yes. Students must be supervised at all times.

**Q. Our whole family would like to go see the author(s). Will there be a public session?**

A. The Festival expects to hold open sessions for the children's authors. Details will be available in the programme online at [www.festival.org.hk](http://www.festival.org.hk)

**Q. Will the authors be able to make school visits?**

A. Although the Festival is grateful for such requests and enthusiasm, we regret that due to overwhelming demand and the desire to accommodate as many schools as possible, Jeremy Strong will be appearing exclusively at Festival sessions in central locations.

**Q. We'd like to start reading the authors' books. Where can we get them?**

A. Paddyfield.com will be offering special discounts and opportunities to buy the books. This information will be distributed together with the notification to schools.
